Begins the word kavana with the root meaning "to aim". Intentionality, will power, and one pointedness of mind.

Kaph / Khaf

"k as in kite"

no dot: ch as in bach

Sofit form

k, kh

The sole difference between the letter Kaf and the letter Khaf is the presence or absence of the dagesh mark (dot in the middle). With the dagesh mark pronounce as "k"; otherwise pronounce as "kh".
